Announcements/Reminders – the daily bulletin email is staying in place for now. Daily Bulletin announcement Mandatory Employee Trainings, they are actually mandatory need to be completed

Deans have been told by the provost that they will be told the number of lines released in October

Friday October 18th - timeline and requirements for sabbatical requests. Please follow the rubric so you understand how your proposal will be evaluated. Don't know how many are going to be funded.

Question – the candidate now must explain how their classes will be covered?

Kelly – We need this information, so someone must explain it.

OTPS – Originally told they were going to be cut by 50%. Fortunately, it was 14-18% range for cuts in departments. Deans reconciled cuts from recommendations. Lots of cuts in places with large allocations that weren't being used, for example \$3,800 in postage. Chairs cannot allocate OTPS as travel funding allocations for faculty travel. Dean's office will provide travel funding now – w/in United States \$800, international travel \$1,000. Planning to change to tenured \$1,000 and untenured \$1,200. Foundation accounts can be used for travel as long as it is within the scope of the account.

Academic Affairs reorganization meetings – Thank you to everyone that went. Very important. There is a survey that closes on October 11th so please be sure that you provide your feedback to the provost.

Statement from the floor – they are refusing to fill it out. It is poorly constructed and forces you to choose an answer even if you don't want any of the responses. No option for N/A or none of the above.

Interim Dean will share this feedback with the provost.

Provost will be holding meetings in October with some financial information and perhaps preliminary results of the survey.

Academic convocation was yesterday. Congratulations to Kevin Williams - SUNY Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Faculty Service, Timothy Bryant - SUNY Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Teaching and Margaret Herb - President's Award for Excellence in Teaching. If there is a recording, please watch Gerard Puccio's keynote address about change. It was framed in a really positive way.

Many upcoming events – Fall Pumpkin Drop, Hispanic Heritage Month with several events. Major Minor fair is Oct 10, Beyond Boundaries events, so many music events, art event, Biology and Great Lakes center speaker series, several other speaker series. Share in the positive and amazing things that we are doing.

Question from floor: Can we surplus fax machines?

Answer: No one is using fax machines. Never heard an answer about this. Will reach out and find out if we are supposed to surplus them. Dean's office has kept one just in case anyone has a need for it.
